Plot Map:

Exposition

• Opening scene- narrator describes the setting

- Eyes darting across from person to person
 - Sees a typical romance
 - Sees someone yelling at someone on the phone dressed in a suit
 - Sees little kids playing and swinging around a tree
- Someone coming out of the cafe- wind gust- coffee spills on them
- They go inside the cafe and come out with a new set of khakis and new
- colorful button up- unbothered- sits back down on bench

Complications

- Person who spilled coffee on them sits next to them and starts sobbing because they feel so bad
- They don't know what to do because they're socially awkward and don't understand the situation so they start patting them on the head and goes back to people-watching
- Next to the cafe is a music store and they see little kid come out with their mom so excited to have bought a new keyboard
- They start crying too and the people lay on each other's shoulders and sob together.

• Rising Action

- It's the next day and the person is wearing a button up with musical instruments on it
- Narrator notices a different presence the person is carrying and how they can't focus on people-watching
- Narrator reveals that they used to people-watch and that the person they have been watching was finally ready to move on.

Climax

- Narrator introduces themselves to the main character and they have a talk about people-watching and finding a direction in life.
- Narrator convinces them to go back home and practice playing the piano- start college in the spring, and enjoy their life

Falling Action

- They follow the narrator's instructions and parents see them and are very happy
- Resolution
 - Moves to Washington and starts life at Puget Sound.
