

Narrative Film Synopsis

My partner Joe and I are making a narrative film about two friends who rely on each other to function but are on the run from the law. The working title of this film is “Pair of Crutches.”

The first act starts off with a bank robbery. The cops are trying to figure out who perpetrated the crime. The scene switches to two best friends walking down the street.
