FADE IN:

MILO

EXT. SUBURBAN HOUSE - DAY

As Milo exits his house, he hears a SHOUT come from his neighbor's house. He turns his head in the direction of the noise, and rushes to enter his car. As he reverses out, he sees his neighbor, LILY (17), standing at the end of his driveway.

He immediately brakes, jerking the car to a halt. Lily skips to the driver's side door and KNOCKS on the window. Milo hesitantly rolls down his window.

LILY

Hey, my car's windshield is broken. Could you give me a ride to school?

Milo nods, motioning Lily to get in the car. Lily walks to the other side of the car and gets in.

LILY (CONT'D)

Thanks.

Milo nods again, reversing out of the driveway.

INT. CAR - MOVING - DAY

Milo and Lily are driving in complete silence. It's getting really awkward. Lily is visibly upset about her car. Milo notices and musters up the courage to ask her a question.

MILO

(quietly)

So what happened to your car?

LILY

(snarkily)

Well, somehow my windshield broke overnight. Like it was completely fine and in one piece yesterday, but now it's completely shattered!

MILO

Mm.

LILY

And now I can't even drive to school anymore so now I'm just screwed!

(scoffing)

How does a windshield even break itself?! Did you hear anything last night?

Milo purses his lips and shakes his head. They continue on in silence, Milo staring directly out the windshield and Lily staring nowhere in particular.

MILO

(abruptly)

How'd you sleep?

Lily slowly turns to Milo. She is confused. It's quiet for a second.

LILY

What?

MILO

Oh. I just, uh, asked how you slept.

LILY

No, I heard you. Um, fine, I guess. What about you?

MILO

I slept great.

Lily nods and stares out the window.

EXT. SCHOOL PARKING LOT - DAY

Milo pulls into a parking spot. Lily exits the car. As she closes the door, Lily turns back to Milo.

LILY

Hey, by the way, I'm gonna need a ride back home too. Okay, thanks!

Lily closes the door. Milo hangs his head, accidentally knocking forward and hitting the horn. Milo leaves the car and is greeted by Shawn.

SHAWN

Yo Milo! What's up? Who was that?

MILO

Oh that's my neighbor Lily. Remember last night when I threw my ball over the fence? I kinda accidentally broke her windshield...

SHAWN

... You what? Well, does she know that you did... that?

MILO

No, I couldn't tell her.

SHAWN

Yeah, of course you couldn't.
C'mon, let's go.

EXT. SUBURBAN HOUSE - DAY

Milo walks out of his house and sees Lily standing on the passenger side of his car.

LILY

Hey, my car's still broken.

MILO

Okay. Get in.

INT. CAR - MOVING - DAY

Milo and Lily are driving to school.

MILO

So when will your car be fixed?

LILY

Oh I don't know, it might be a while.

EXT. SUBURBAN HOUSE - DAY

Lily is waiting by Milo's car again, holding breakfast in her hands for the both of them. Milo grabs some and they both get into the car.

EXT. SCHOOL - DAY

Milo approaches Lily, who is standing with her friend. She welcomes him into the conversation. They all share a laugh.

INT. CAR - MOVING - DAY

Milo and Lily are in the car together again. Milo is saying something while facing the road. Lily is looking at him and laughing.

EXT. SUBURBAN HOUSE - DAY

LILY

MILO

MILO

INT. CAR - MOVING - DAY

Milo is driving alone, tapping the steering wheel with his fingers. He is focused on the road.

MILO

EXT. SCHOOL PARKING LOT - DAY

Shawn is waiting by his car. Milo parks his car and exits, approaching his friend.

SHAWN

Where's Lily?

MILO

Uh, well, I don't know. I told her about the windshield, and I think it's fair to say she didn't take it well.

SHAWN

I told you you should've confessed sooner!

MILO

Yeah, I know.

SHAWN

Are you gonna do anything about
it?

Milo's silent, but notices Lily walking by. He nods.

MILO

EXT. SUBURBAN HOUSE - DAY

Milo sits on the sidewalk, waiting for Lily to come home.
Eventually, he sees her car pull up to her driveway and

LILY

MILO

Lily wait! Please just hear me
out.

Lily pauses and turns to face Milo.

MILO (CONT'D)

LILY

and everything.

LILY
