REI

GREGORY (DISTORTED BY THE MIC)

Rei's neighbor starts to walk away, then turns back around.

Hey, I miss you Rei. You've always been so friendly around the neighborhood. This new trend of yours has me worried. Please reach out if you need to.

For a second, Rei looks distraught. Rei sighs, then turns to TAY, her a.i assistant.

REI

TAY

EXT. PARK - DAY

REI

TREVOR

REI

GREGORY

Rei looks at the dashboard of the car with a look of sorrow.

REI
